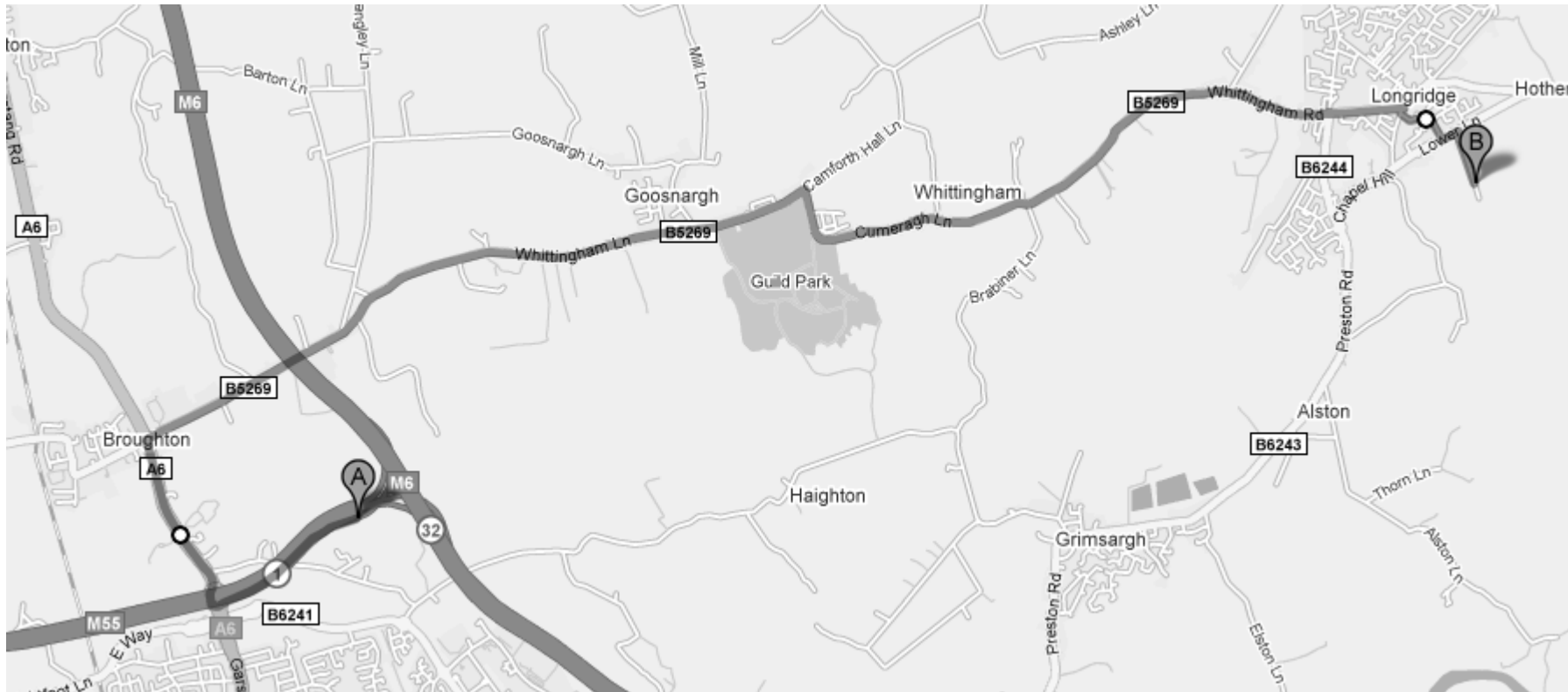


## From M6 North / South



- Head North / South on M6
- Leave the M6 at junction 32 to join the M55
- Immediately keep left, then at roundabout take the 3rd exit onto the A6
- At Broughton Crossroads, traffic signals turn right onto Whittingham Lane - B5269
- At roundabout take the 2nd exit onto Kestor Lane - B5269
- Turn right onto Fell Brow
- Turn left onto Risedale Drive
- Turn left onto Lower Lane - B6243
- Arrive on Lower Lane
- Turn right (see Sign Circle signpost)

## Walk/Taxi: Preston train station to Bus Station



The nearest train station is Preston station.

It is approx 10 minutes' walk from the train station to the bus station. If you do not want to walk that far you can get a taxi outside the train station to take you to the bus station

- Head east on Fishergate toward Butler Street
- Slight left at Corporation Street
- Continue straight to stay on Corporation Street
- Slight right at A59 / Ring Way
- Turn right at Lancaster Road
- Turn left at Old Vicarage
- Tithebarn Street]

## Bus: Preston Bus station to Longridge Post Office Walk: Longridge Post Office to Campsite



Bus (Bus route No 1) leaves from Preston Bus Station to Longridge Post Office every 10 minutes (10 minute walk to campsite) - When you arrive at the Longridge Post Office:

- Head southeast on Berry Lane toward Irwell Street
- Turn left at B5269 / King Street continue to follow B5269
- Turn right at Calfcote Lane
- Turn right at B6243 / Lower Lane
- Turn left (signposted Sign Circle)

## **Arriving and Check In**

Arriving time is after 2pm on Friday 28th May 2010. When you arrive please check in at the Information Tent with your Festival Ticket. You will be given a wristband and programme. All Sign Circle Campers will have to wear their wristbands that they get upon arrival at ALL times. This is to make sure that no outside people can come in. If your band is lost or broken, go to the Information Tent to get a new one. We ask you to leave the site by 2pm on Monday 31<sup>st</sup> May 2010 so our crew can clear the site

## **Parking**

Cars are not allowed on the fields during camping – only to set up and pack up. There is a designated parking area at the campsite.
